## **TOUCH RUGBY 2010/2011**

Welcome to the 2010/2011 Touch Rugby season. If you would like to sign up to play Touch Rugby this season please collect a registration form from the School Office. It must be completed and returned to the School Office before **Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September**.

**FEES** – Fees are payable to Raumati Beach School before Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September - \$30.00 for the first child in the family and \$15.00 for each subsequent child (*this cost covers registration with Kapiti Touch as well as the school \$5.00 uniform charge*).

**TEAMS** - Each team has limited numbers, with a minimum of 3-4 girls per team. Teams will be populated on a first-in, first-serve basis. So, please return your registration form **together with payment** to the School Office as soon as possible. Teams will be streamed where there is more than one team represented in a grade. This is to ensure all players are given the best opportunity to enjoy the game.

**SEASON DATES** - The 2010 leg of the season runs from Tuesday 19 October to Thursday 16 December, 9 weeks of play. The 2011 leg of the season runs from Tuesday 15 February 2011 to Thursday 24 March 2011, 6 weeks of play. Prize giving dates are listed below:-

## **GAME TIMES**

Tuesdays Under 13, and older  
Wednesdays Under 7, Under 8  
Thursdays Under 9, Under 11

All games are played in the late afternoon, early evening - commencing at 5.30 pm. Confirmed times are yet to be finalised. As a general rule younger age groups are scheduled to play in an earlier time slot where possible.

Grade eligibility is determined by player age as of **January 1<sup>st</sup> 2011** (i.e if you are 7 after this date you are eligible to play in the Under 7 grade).

**RULES** - A simplified version of touch rules are available from the School Office.

**COACHES AND HELPERS REQUIRED** - We require coaches and helpers for each team we enter. No previous experience is needed. If you have any questions regarding coaching a team please feel free to contact me. Touch has one of the highest (if not the highest) participation numbers of any organised primary school team sport and we hope this is because it nurtures some of the positive values of sport – fair play, participation, and fun. Please consider coaching a team. It's really not that hard, and can be a great experience. There will be a 'Coach the Coaches' course on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> October from 10.00 am at Mazengarb Park, please contact me if you are keen to attend this course. If we are unable to secure a coach for a team we will be unable to enter them into the competition.
