 - ~ At school before the bell each morning.
 - ~ Outside on fine days.
 - ~ Obeying the bells promptly.
 - ~ Using the toilet areas sensibly.
 - ~ Playing on the playground equipment.
- 3 I WILL ACT AND SPEAK KINDLY TO EVERYBODY IN OUR SCHOOL FAMILY BY . . .**
 - ~ Being polite and friendly to everyone.
 - ~ Not name calling, teasing, or saying nasty things to others.
 - ~ Not bullying anyone.
 - ~ Telling my feelings in words when I am angry or upset, rather than by behaving badly.
 - ~ Using polite language such as “please”, “thank you”, “sorry”, and so on.

 - ~ I will hand in at the Office any money or things I find.
 - ~ I will ask before I borrow.

 - ~ I will care for equipment and return it to its proper place.
